Why Are We Selling Papers?

K C Day is a yearly fund raiser that helps support K C Rotary Youth Camp Foundation and other youth activities.

The K C Star donates papers and game tickets so this event is possible.

The original Club 13 (Kansas City) youth camp closed in 1923. Mr. Robert Gee, then Club 13 President, and his wife felt so strongly that the camp experience should be available, they purchased 40 acres by Lake Jacomo on Colburn Road in Lee's Summit. The land was placed in trust by the Gees in 1928 and Club 13 was granted exclusive use of it in perpetuity for activities in service to youth.

Summer sessions are devoted to groups who serve physically, emotionally and mentally disabled youth from the Greater Kansas City area. The camp boasts one of the few specially designed swimming pools for special needs children in the Midwest. Summer sessions provide all camp facilities to over 1500 campers at no charge to the organizations who use it. The facility can comfortably feed 240 campers at a sitting. Off-season campers have totaled more than 5000 per season.

A yearly operating budget in excess of \$200,000 is why we're selling papers.

If you don't like early morning street corners, you can buy a bundle of 25 papers for \$25 and the Star will personalize the bundle, deliver them to you, or a charity, and you can give them away or sell them from the comfort of your own business. How cool is that?
