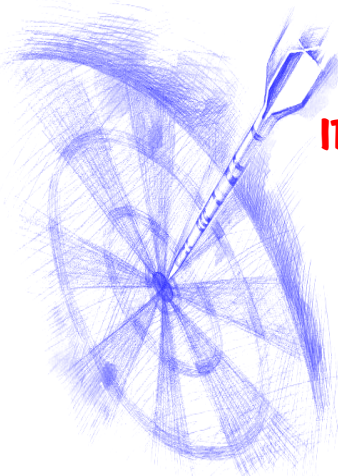

Present: Tate Wood, Daryl Bohannon, Helen Budinger, Jim Murphy, Gabe Schweizer, Jim Corless, Dave Kauffman, Phil Klinkhardt, Jill Filer, Nancy Shelton, Nancy Linthicum, Lorene Wilson, and Cindy Greenwell.

The minutes of the April 3 meeting were approved.  
The treasurer's report was approved.

**Old Business**

Tate reported that she is working to form a committee to oversee the scholarship program including the endowment. The committee will include three voting members and three non-voting members (president, secretary and treasurer).

Nancy S. contacted Bennett signs regarding an aluminum sign for the club's Centennial project. She received a bid of \$150 for a 3x3 sign. Jim M. had also received a quote from a monument company for approximately \$200 for an in-ground marker. Lorene made a motion to move forward with the aluminum sign. Jim C. seconded the motion. The motion passed. Lorene will take the design to the Park Board for approval.

**New Business**

Daryl Bohannon provided an overview of the Young Life organization in Harrisonville. He requested Rotary's continued support of that organization at a level of \$1,500.

Cindy Greenwell talked to the Board about the school's contribution to the Rotary Basketball Tournament. Rotary is not charged any fee for the usage of the facilities. In the past, she said the club has donated to a school project in appreciation of the services provided for the tournament. The athletic department has requested funds to purchase two TVs and VCR/DVD players for the basketball/volleyball locker rooms. The board voted to fund this purchase totaling \$2,000 out of the 2007-08 budget.

Daryl provided information to the Board regarding a new project of the district. Next year, Harrisonville will host a high school basketball holiday tournament. They will be looking for community support. Daryl suggested a donation of \$1,000. The Board will consider this request at a later date.

Tate will be attending the district conference this weekend in Sedalia. Emanuele will also be attending.

The Board received a request from the library for a donation to purchase incentives for the summer reading program. The donation must be under \$200 (any donation over \$200 must be used for books). Jim made a motion to donate the Change the World proceeds through the end of May, not to exceed \$200, to the Summer Reading program to purchase incentives. Nancy L. seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Jill presented a request from the Early Childhood Center for the purchase of glasses for a pre-kindergarten student. There are still funds with the hospital foundation that are earmarked for use by the Rotary Club to purchase glasses. Nancy L. made a motion to fund this request using the hospital foundation funds. Nancy S. seconded the motion. The motion passed.

There was discussion regarding potential new members. Helen will print a list of names in the upcoming newsletter.

Jill is planning to place an order for new member shirts, hats and name buttons. She will pass around an order form at the next meeting for anyone who would like to place personal orders for Rotary apparel.

Phil presented information regarding potential projects for 2007-08, as well as a preliminary budget for next year.

Tate will provide nomination forms at the next meeting for the Rotarian of the Year Award.

The Board discussed Paul Harris fellows as well as the sustaining member program.

The next Board meeting is Tuesday, June 5.

The meeting adjourned at 8:40 a.m.
