The original Club 13 (Kansas City) youth camp **CLOSED IN 1923**. Mr. Robert Gee, then Club 13 President, and his wife felt so strongly that the camp experience should be available, they purchased 40 acres by Lake Jacomo on Colburn Road in Lee's Summit. The land was placed in trust by the Gees in 1928 and Club 13 was granted exclusive use of it in perpetuity for activities in service to youth.
