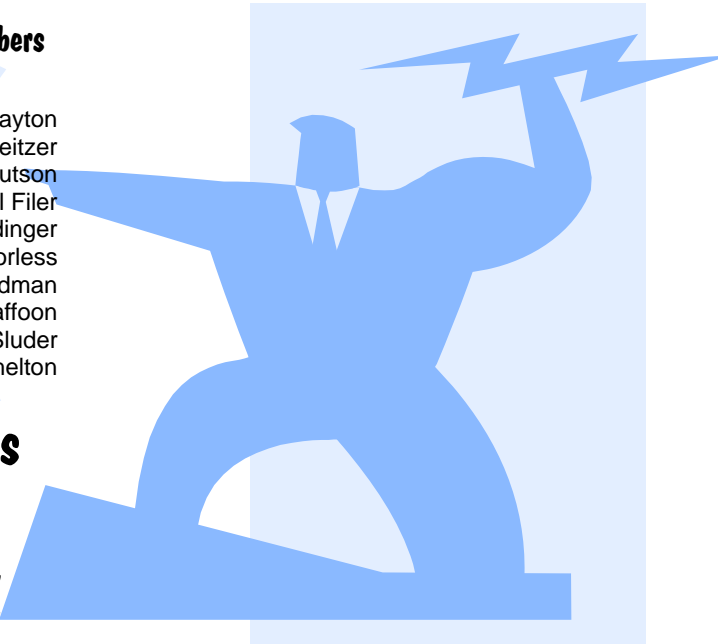

DIVISIONS: Boys: Grades 4h thru 8th  
ENTRY FEE: \$175.00 per Team  
ENTRY DEADLINE: January 30, 2008

PROOF OF GRADE: Recent report card or signed letter by a school official required.  
Proof must be available at each game if requested by tournament officials.

ADMISSION: Adults/ \$2.00 Under 12/ \$1.00 Under 5/ Free  
TEAM LIMIT: 10 players per team, all rosters turned in before first game are final.  
GAMES: 3 Game guarantee. No more than 8 teams per division (no AAU teams).  
Entry awarded upon receipt of entry fee.

AWARDS: TEAM Plaque for 1st and 2nd. Individual trophies for 1st, individual medals for 2nd, 3rd and Consolation.

**RULES**

Players must register and compete with only 1 team. Discovery of ineligible player participation in a game will result in team forfeiture of entire tournament and fee.

Anyone displaying un-sportsmanlike conduct will be suspended from the tournament.  
This includes any spectator.

4th –6th divisions will use smaller 28.5 basketball

Six-minute quarters with one minute between quarters and five minutes between halves

Five-minute warm-up time before games

No pressing by a team that holds a 20-point or greater lead.

2 full and 2 / 30-second time outs per game

You must bring your own game balls for warm-ups.

Players may play up in the grade level brackets but not down.

Overtime periods will be 2:00 minutes with 1 extra 30-second time out.

MSHAA official rules will be followed except as set out above.
